

#### Goals:

- Promoting the development of social entrepreneurship to engage socially vulnerable youth and alleviate poverty in Georgia and Ukraine.
- Implementing measures aligned with the Go Green and Go Digital agenda by state and public organizations.



# Participants:

- Conflict-affected and socially vulnerable young people in Georgia and Ukraine.
- School students and teachers.
- Vulnerable young women and men from 6 regions (3 in Georgia and 3 in Ukraine).
- Young people affected by conflict, including those facing war and forced displacement in Ukraine.
- Young people not involved in education, employment, or training (NEETs) from Georgia and Ukraine.



#### Results:



Estonia's best practices and experience in the social entrepreneurship and career management sectors will be introduced in Georgia and Ukraine.



Digital and non-digital tools and methodologies for online and face-to-face social entrepreneurship courses will be developed with the technical support of Tallinn University, based on the Estonian model.



An innovative Go Green and Go Digital social entrepreneurship incubator model will be created and implemented in Georgia.



Georgian partners will share knowledge and modern teaching approaches with Ukrainian counterparts to help rebuild Ukraine by introducing innovative principles of social entrepreneurship and career management.



In the three target municipalities of Georgia (Kaspi, Khoni, and Zugdidi), regional incubators will be established to implement project activities.



Young people equipped with new knowledge will establish social enterprises in Georgia. In the future, these enterprises will create opportunities for employment and self-employment in collaboration with the public and private sectors.



Social enterprises will be established by young people in Ukraine, providing early recovery opportunities. These enterprises will be prepared to meet the urgent needs of society in the future.



In partnership with state institutions, the career management skills of school-aged youth living in the regions of Georgia will be improved. The experience gained will be transferred to the Ukrainian side.
