DRC Response

DRC works to protect and support refugees arriving in Denmark from Ukraine through:

- Asylum counselling and protection support to refugees arriving from Ukraine
- Assistance to national and local authorities to receive and possibly integrate refugees arriving from Ukraine
- Direct support to a dignified life in Denmark through DRC's large and nationwide network of volunteers
- Coordination and technical assistance to support mobilisation among the Danish population and particularly the Ukrainian diaspora seeking to support refugees arriving from Ukraine

DRC Response in Denmark

Since its establishment in 1956, DRC has played a leading role when it comes to protection of refugee and asylum seeker rights, integration support, and volunteer mobilisation to assist refugees and asylum seekers in Denmark.

DRC stands on a solid platform of both providing legal and integration counselling to refugees and asylum seekers, provision of technical assistance to the Danish authorities and, as a civil society actor, mobilise volunteers in locally led people-to-people integration support.

Recognising the considerable mobilisation among the Ukrainian diaspora, DRC focuses particularly on supporting their response efforts in Denmark. In collaboration between the long-standing volunteer and diaspora engagement, DRC has established an overview of the needs of refugees arriving from Ukraine and support the coordination of joint civil society efforts to provide relevant assistance.
